

DEED OF GIFT
AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY

This trophy was donated by BARRY BOURKE, a successful Sydney Marine Dealer and outboard driver who started racing in the 45c.i. class in the 1960s, going on to race 1250cc and 1750 cc mono and open hull class boats until retiring from racing in 1985. This trophy was originally donated in 1975 for the 45c.i. Sports outboard (this class originally commenced competition in 1969). At the AGM in 1976 class changed to 750cc and in 1985 was increased to 800cc. The trophy is now deeded for ANNUAL COMPETITION between OUTBOARD powered OPEN HULL class boats of 800cc engine capacity and is known as

BARRY BOURKE TROPHY


This DEED OF GIFT has been prepared to suit current Rules & Regulations of the Australian Powerboat Association and replaces all Deeds of Gift prior to the date of this document.

1. The TROPHY shall be awarded to the WINNER of the AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP for the 800cc OPEN HULL OUTBOARD class.
2. The DATE and VENUE of the CHAMPIONSHIP shall be allocated according to the CURRENT RULES of the Australian Powerboat Association.
3. The CHAMPIONSHIP shall be conducted in accordance with the CURRENT RULES of the Australian Powerboat Association for the nominated class and the APBA decision in all respects shall be final.
4. The CLUB or COUNCIL conducting the CHAMPIONSHIP shall supply a commemorative trophy to the WINNER each year. Championship CERTIFICATES shall be provided in accordance with the current RULES of the Australian Powerboat Association.
5. The TROPHY is vested in the Australian Powerboat Association and the holding and display of the TROPHY shall be at the discretion of the AUSTRALIAN POWERBOAT ASSOCIATION. The HOLDER of the TROPHY shall be responsible for its safekeeping and general condition. If the WINNER is the holder of the trophy the WINNER is responsible for the safe return of the TROPHY prior to the next contest as the RULES of the Australian Powerboat Association.

This AMENDED DEED OF GIFT was ACCEPTED on behalf of the Australian Powerboat Association at the COUNCIL MEETING on this twelfth day of May 2018.
