

DEED OF GIFT

AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY

This Trophy was donated by the late **Mr. COL BROWN** on 24 January 1972 as a **PERPETUAL TROPHY** for **ANNUAL** competition for the **OZ LITES 1.6 LITRE RESTRICTED MOTOR CLASS** (previously known as the Australian Formula Ford Class) and is known as the:

COL BROWN TROPHY

1. The TROPHY shall be presented to the winner of the AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP for the Class described above, an Event open to Oz Lites 1.6 Litre Restricted Motor Class Boats only, which shall be conducted in accordance with the Class rules set from time to time by the Oz Lites 1.6 Litre Boating Register and approved by the Australian Power Boat Association.
2. The TROPHY will be competed for ANNUALLY at such venue/s and date/s as may be decided by the Oz Lites 1.6 Litre Boating Register and approved by the Australian Power Boat Association.
3. Drivers and Boat Owners competing for The TROPHY must, at all times, comply with the Class rules as set by The Oz Lites 1.6 Litre Boating Register and approved by the Australian Power Boat Association.
4. The TROPHY will be vested in the Australian Power Boat Association, but possession of the TROPHY will, from time to time be by the Oz Lites 1.6 Litre Boating Register, Club, or Owner of the winning boat which represented the Club at the last competition, subject to its safe custody as may be deemed reasonable by the Australian Power Boat Association.
5. The TROPHY will be returned, as stated in the Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association, and the Council, Club or Person taking possession of the TROPHY will be deemed to have received the TROPHY in good condition unless a report is furnished to the Australian Power Boat Association, within fourteen (14) days, stating otherwise.
6. Championship Certificates are to be provided by the Australian Power Boat Association in accordance with the current Rules, but the INSCRIPTION on the TROPHY will be the responsibility of the Oz Lites 1.6 Litre Boating Register.
7. ENTRIES will only be accepted on the condition that the craft entered and the competitor, or any person or persons connected therewith, whilst preparing for, and or participating in the Event, shall do so at their own risk and such persons shall have no claim against the Australian Power Boat Association, or any Official or Servant appointed or acting on behalf of the said Association in connection with the Event for any Injuries suffered by himself or to any persons, or in respect to damage to the craft entered.
