

AUSTRALASIAN CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY.

This TROPHY was donated by Mr. E. C. GRIFFITH in 1912 as a PERPETUAL TROPHY for ANNUAL Competition between INBOARD Section, OPEN Hull Class Boats of UNLIMITED Engine Capacity and is known as the

E. C. GRIFFITH CUP

This DEED of GIFT replaces all previous Deed of Gift as a result of Notices of Motion accepted at the Annual Meeting of the Australian Power Boat Association, 27th. and 28th. July 1985.

1. The TROPHY shall be preserved as a perpetual TROPHY for CLUBS affiliated with the Australian Power Boat Association.
2. The TROPHY shall be presented to the winner of the AUSTRALASIAN CHAMPIONSHIP for the Class herein described.
3. The DATE and VENUE of the CHAMPIONSHIP shall be allocated according to, and NOTIFICATION of the CHAMPIONSHIP shall be consistent with, the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association.
4. The CLUB represented by the winning boat should have the right to conduct the CHAMPIONSHIP the following year.
5. There shall be no restriction on power or hull design, excepting as set down by the Australian Power Boat Association Rules, in definition of a Speedboat.
6. The CHAMPIONSHIP shall be under the control of the Australian Power Boat Association, whose decision in all respects shall be final, and the said Association shall have power from time to time to alter or amend the Rules and Regulations governing the CHAMPIONSHIP, not inconsistent with this Deed.
7. The TROPHY shall be vested in the Australian Power Boat Association and shall be held in a BANK SAFE DEPOSIT unless the Owner of the winning boat, or the Club represented by the winning boat, can give an undertaking that arrangements have been made for the safe custody of the TROPHY which are satisfactory to the Australian Power Boat Association.
8. The CLUB or COUNCIL conducting the CHAMPIONSHIP shall supply a commemorative trophy to the winner of the CHAMPIONSHIP each year. Championship Certificates shall be provided in accordance with the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association.
9. All entries are to be in accordance with the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association.
10. The CHAMPIONSHIP shall be conducted in accordance with the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association.

This AMENDED DEED of GIFT was ACCEPTED on behalf of the Australian Power Boat Association this twentyseventh day of October 1985.
