

DEED of GIFT.

AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY.

This TROPHY was purchased by the Australian Power Boat Association in 1985 as a PERPETUAL TROPHY for ANNUAL Competition between 1800cc. Capacity STOCK Outboard Motor Powered, MONO Hull Class Boats and is known as the

EXECUTIVE TROPHY

and has been inscribed with the names of the previous Class winners.

1. The TROPHY shall be presented to the Winner of the AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP for the Class described, an Event open to Outboard Motor Powered Craft only, the Owners and Drivers of which shall be Members of a Club affiliated with the Australian Power Boat Association.
2. The TROPHY shall be competed for ANNUALLY at such Venue and Date as may be decided, and the Event conducted, in accordance with the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association.
3. The TROPHY shall be vested in the Australian Power Boat Association, but the possession of the TROPHY shall, from time to time, be held by the Club, or the Owner of the Boat which represented such Club at the last competition, subject to its safe custody as may be deemed reasonable by the Australian Power Boat Association.
4. Should the required number of entries be not received for the period stated in the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association, or should the Class for which the TROPHY was donated become redundant, the TROPHY may then be reallocated to another active Class at the descretion of the Australian Power Boat Association.
5. The TROPHY shall be returned prior to the Championship each year as required by the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association, and such COUNCIL, CLUB, or PERSON taking possession of the TROPHY shall be deemed to have received the TROPHY in good condition unless a report is furnished to the FEDERAL SECRETARY in writing, within fourteen days, stating otherwise.
6. Championship CERTIFICATES shall be provided in accordance with the current Rules of the Australian Power Boat Association, but the INSCRIPTION on the TROPHY shall be the responsibility of the winning Owner.
7. ENTRIES will only be accepted on the condition that the craft entered and the Competitor, or any Person or Persons connected therewith, whilst preparing for, and or participating in the Event, shall do so at their own risk and such Persons shall have no claim against the Australian Power Boat Association, or the Donor, or any Official or Servant appointed or acting on behalf of the said Association or Donor in connection with the Event, for any injuries suffered by himself or to any Persons, or in respect of damages to the craft entered.
