

**DEED OF GIFT**  
**AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY**

The Trophy was donated by Ken France, a former National and NSW Council President, UIM Gold Medal recipient and an inboard race boat owner/driver in the 1950s, 60s, and early 1970s with a 155ci class skiff MARLO and a hydroplane HEPCAT.

The trophy was originally donated for the 61c.i. OPEN SPORTS OUTBOARD class in 1975 (changed to 1000cc in 1978). The trophy was reallocated to the 1000cc SUPER SPORTS class in 1980.

At the AGM in 1989 the class was increased to 1250cc and the trophy deeded for ANNUAL COMPETITION between OUTBOARD powered OPEN hull class boats with 1250cc engine capacity and is known as


**KEN FRANCE TROPHY**

This DEED OF GIFT has been prepared to suit current Rules & Regulations of the Australian Powerboat Association and replaces all Deeds of Gift prior to the date of this document.

1. The TROPHY shall be awarded to the WINNER of the AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIP for the 1250cc SUPER SPORTS outboard class.
2. The DATE and VENUE of the CHAMPIONSHIP shall be allocated according to the CURRENT RULES of the Australian Powerboat Association.
3. The CHAMPIONSHIP shall be conducted in accordance with the CURRENT RULES of the Australian Powerboat Association whose decision in all respects shall be final.
4. The CLUB or COUNCIL conducting the CHAMPIONSHIP shall supply a commemorative trophy to the WINNER each year. Championship CERTIFICATES shall be provided in accordance with the current RULES of the Australian Powerboat Association.
5. The TROPHY is vested in the Australian Powerboat Association and the holding and display of the TROPHY shall be at the discretion of the AUSTRALIAN POWERBOAT ASSOCIATION. The HOLDER of the TROPHY shall be responsible for its safekeeping and general condition. If the WINNER is the holder of the trophy the WINNER is responsible for the safe return of the TROPHY prior to the next contest as the RULES of the Australian Powerboat Association.

This AMENDED DEED OF GIFT was ACCEPTED on behalf of the Australian Powerboat Association at the COUNCIL MEETING on this twelfth day of May 2018.
