only. Boats must be scrutineered and all drivers' breath tested before


entering on to the water.

Breath Testing:

Breath testing will be conducted immediately prior to the drivers briefing on each day of competition. Random alcohol and drug tests will be conducted throughout each day. All drivers and officials must undergo a breath test and record a zero reading on each day of competition and when requested for random breath testing. If a positive reading is returned, that driver cannot compete at that day's racing. If the breath analysis equipment is considered faulty, Officials may afford a driver a second test or use other breath analysis equipment if available. Such a test is to be conducted (as per Rule 201.096) within 10 (ten) minutes of the original test or the minimum recommended interval as given by the manufacturer of the equipment.

Pits:

The Pits are located within the boat and trailer parking and up the top of the hill of the Melbourne Runabout and Speedboat Club. There is plenty of room for small and large Transporters, as well as cars and trailers. Extra cars will not be permitted in the pits on Saturday or Sunday. There are enough car spaces outside of the pits for crew and family cars. Under no circumstances will smoking, consumption of alcohol and the lighting of BBQ's be tolerated.
